STONEWALL FARM'S mission is to connect people to the land and to the role of agriculture in their lives. We are the only working dairy farm and education center in the region open to the public. We operate a 30 head certified organic dairy, a year

round community supported agriculture (CSA) garden, and a Learning Center that draws 20,000 visitors per year.

The facility is used for education programs for schools and the public, children's camps, conferences and workshops, and is available to rent for special events. Visitors are welcome to hike trails, meet small animals and explore the barn anytime. Programs, Learning Center hours, the farm stand and CSA change seasonally. Please contact us for details.

# CAMP PROGRAMS

## Peepers > Ages 4 & 5

Get to know farm animals, explore gardens, forests and fields and make new friends. Structured activities and supervised free exploration are balanced to provide a fun and welcoming experience.

**\$220/child; \$200/child for members.**

## Ramblers > Entering grades 1 & 2 (6-7 year olds)

Begin each day with farm chores, then enjoy a sampling of all the farm offers, from the barn to the garden to the kitchen. Camp crafts, traditional games and nature hikes round out this exciting program.

**\$210/child; \$190/child for members**

## Pioneers > Entering grades 3 & 4 (8-9 year olds)

Explore our gardens and animals as a food and fiber source. Crafts, farm-based recipes and adventures in our natural areas deepen an understanding of the farm. Pioneers have the option of staying for the Thursday night campout!

**\$210/child; \$190/child for members**

## Explorers > Entering grades 5 & 6 (10-11 year olds)

Learn more about the jobs and specific skills required to be a farmer. It's not all work - there's time to keep cool by the creek and hike our trails. Explorers have a Thursday night overnight option.

**\$210/child; \$190/child for members**

## Wanderers > Entering grades 7- 9 (12-14 year olds)

This leadership-based program focuses on the self as part of the group. From team driving to farm stand management, experience the real work of the farm.

**\$210/child; \$190 for members**

## Counselor-in-Training > Entering grades 9-10 (14 &15 year olds)

Learn about the important and fulfilling role of being a camp counselor. This 3-week program focuses on developing leadership skills. Learn camp activities, gain experience working with groups of campers while being mentored by our professional camp counselors, and polish interview skills through a "mock" interview at the end of the summer.

**\$400/child; \$360 for members** > CITs completing the 3-week program may sign up for **Experience Weeks**.

These will be spent assisting younger camp groups (with continued guidance). **\$75/week**

### Important Camp Details

- >  Camp Hours are 9:00 am - 3:00 pm. After care is available until 5:30 pm Monday-Thursday.
- >  Family picnic nights are Thursdays from 5:30 - 7:00 pm.

- >  Camper to Counselor ratios are 10 to 2.
- >  Fees include a camp t-shirt.
- >  Financial assistance is available to qualifying families.

## OUR STAFF

Our experienced educators enjoy sharing their love of the farm and the outdoors. All staff are certified in First Aid and CPR and state background checks are required.

## AFTER CAMP CARE

- >  A limited number of after care spaces are available from 3:00 pm to 5:30 pm. There is no after care on Fridays.
- >  Fee: \$25/day or \$70/Monday-Thursday
- >  Advanced registration of at least 24 hours is required.
- >  Refunds are given if we receive cancellation within 48 hours.

## REGISTRATION

- >  Campers with a Family Membership or greater have priority registration beginning February 20th. Registration to the general public opens March 12th.
- >  Register by mail (use attached form) or phone (603) 357-7278. A \$50 non-refundable deposit for each session is required.
- >  A mailed registration does NOT guarantee a space until confirmed.
- >  You will receive a confirmation packet with detailed information and health forms. **Balance of payment is due May 14, 2012.**

## CANCELLATIONS, REFUNDS & DATE CHANGES

- >  Full refund (minus deposit) if cancelled at least 4 weeks before camp starts.
- >  50% refund (minus deposit) if cancelled at least 2 weeks before camp starts.
- >  No refunds for camp days missed.
- >  \$30 processing fee for changing session dates.
